1. FAIR DISTRICTS FOR NM requesting support for a constitutional amendment for an independent redistricting committee for 2031.

- IN FAVOR - A commission is a good idea. Does it reduce the opposing side winning a law suit? (No), depends on the commission and their process. Central issue in our Democracy. It gives credibility. Good compromise until feds do their job.
- AGAINST - Might have said yes, until hearing from Mimi, saying we need an edge to keep Dems in. NY has Fair Districts had a plan and could never agree so legislature took over. Legislature was cavalier in rejecting it.
- SUGGESTIONS - Ask Paula. She is 100% in favor. Let's go with her. Plenty of time to remove our name.

ACTION: SOS Leadership agrees unanimously to stay on the Fair Districts for NM list of supporters.
