- Feedback from canvassing this past weekend: people are talking about crime, inflation.
- Update on Law Enforcement Project Rachel/Committee. Rachel is working with Dept of Public Safety leadership, drafting legislation for Strengthening Law Enforcement Infrastructure and Instructional Improvement. Introducing mentoring coaching and apprenticeships, something not heard of in this industry; carrots vs the sticks they currently utilize exclusively. Once there's a bill we can shop it around to build a coalition. Hoping Cervantes will carry it. Will present to CCJ interim committee prior to Thanksgiving. Thank you Rachel and Civil rights/criminal justice committee
- Supreme Court will be hearing a case on Indian Child Welfare Act. This is a big threat to Indigenous communities. Let's focus on the Supreme Court this year as they are gearing up and will be VERY conservative. Sandy will ask Lauren about Indivisible National's perspective on how we can influence this situation. Increase the number of Justices?
- Concern for MLG getting re-elected.

Our speaker today, Eliza Sultan, who has been working on legislation to protect children who have to testify in court in cases of abuse.

How can we help? Who would be the best Senator to carry this legislation? Bill O'Neill.... LTEs. TV exposure, NM in Focus. Easiest path would be via regulation, making necessary changes. Groups to partner with: American Humane society, Girl's inc, Marguerite Salazar, former superintendent of Rules of NM, head of rules head of Concerned Women for Family Development (cwfd)-Barbara Vigil, research on regulations done by thanksgiving.

Reforming Child Testimony Committee will be reformed to support this effort, after the election.
