    - In addition: it is here. They are producing it in (ABQ) and it is unregulated.

    - HB 4 environmental green amendment. Constitutional . Next week the author of the Green Amendment will be with us. HB 32 energy storage. HB122 Radioactive .

- Now they work with allies to help prioritize. Last Sunday he was on the phone with Amanda Viscosli - there are at least 7 bills. She helped narrow it down :
  - Assault bill. Amanda believes handguns and automatic rifles. But she will be behind Assault. Raise the age for automatic rifle for 21. Brain development not there.
- Retake's communication: Blog/alert system, Huddles.
- Peter Wirth: they won't allow junior money, can't be used for studies, etc. It's not a good system but has been used for things.

Organized by issue

- Environmental
  - Local choice - allows for local communities to get their energy to get around PNM and get faster to renewables to create their own entity to buy and sell. Cost reducing. \$ from doing this distributed to your community to lower bills. You have control over what you want. Community control. It also includes renewables' target.
  - Green amendment
  - Public Health Climate bill. Create best practice. We will have an extreme heat event. If there are no cooling stations.
  - Water Protection : HB 1. Regionalizing districts. There's no cooperation between the distinct water entities.
  - SB57 Senator Wirth - water trust fund.
  - SB 53 HB 122 Stop Holtec You can't ban Holtec, but you can ban the state and its jurisdictions.
- Health Security
  - Studying in the state for years. Mary Feldmblum has been working on it for 25 years. Can serve over 1. 5B on based on what's happening in healthcare in five years.
  - Would address systemic problems negotiate medicaid and medicare coding.
  - Record keeping - making sure everyone is in the system.
  - In Saskatchewan they began studied it, implemented it and all of Canada. We will be the next Saskatchewan. Strong health component.
  - Reena: reproductive freedom act and reproductive health act.
  - Public Health and Climate Resiliency
  - Medicaid forward? More likely to go because she is for it.
  - We've been asked by CC to support SB132. Not on Paul's list
- Economic Justice
  - Paid Family Leave
  - Guaranteed Basic Income - Callabelero will propose a memorial. The govt wants to give back \$ to people like us, there would be \$ for those who need it. Appleseeds NM has a couple of projects with this. There are a few of them. CC college is one to give \$ to help them stay in college
