- Core of Supreme Court decision - unless there was regulation of guns in 1794, they are not considering things more modern. AKA - Original intent
- Different Supreme Court Districts vote differently:
 - 9th district in CA rules one way
 - We are in 5th District rules the other way.
- For our LEGIS: So much gun legislation - can't possible allow all of it.
- The leaders are watching.
- It will apply bills that require constitutional amendment. They don't want to give disproportionate time to guns over others.

- The senate judiciary is looking at it. SB19 is being used as a filter. So there might be not great stuff that will have stuff that will have stuck to it. They are going to filter down and stop all the bills and land on what they think is the best .
- Senate 308 Wirth and Cervantes and review state constitution.
- The cost of taking a constitutional amendment in 24 is being talked about. House is operating in normal way and more flexible. Senate is changing their strategies.

- 2nd amendment issue
 - Cervantes lay ground work to get foundation to move forward on gun violence prevention
 - The one bill they thought they have is safety
 - Every single gun violence prevention law would be going to Supreme Court . Cervantes and Wirth said says why not try. It's not our job not to pass things when it could go to the SP.
 - Legislation that will go forward
 - HB 9 seems good. Child access prevention
 - HB 100 (waiting period) - Romero - will be held on Floor. When it goes to Senate - Cervantes will sponsor this. And if that doesn't work, there is always SB427. She thinks 14 day waiting period will save lives.
 - Cervantes - SB 427 14 day hold on sales
 - They like HB 100 or SB 4127 - there is a huge reduction in suicide and possible 17% reduction. Cooling off period How does it reduce homicide or crimes of passion. So many are crimes of passion.
 - They also give LE time for conducting background. One rep bought a gun in an hour. That's too quick. NOW: if it takes more than 3 days, the store has to give it to the buyer. He would not have passed the background. The person can still buy the gun.
 - Names have to go into NCIC - a list of people who can buy guns. There is a backlog. Not a lot of LE want to take 2nd amendments from people.
 - Senate bill 166 - raise age for semi from 19 - 21.
 - Officer prevention gun violence - dead. There is an office for DWI so why not this.

 - Guys talking before a hearing - throw a bone to gun prevention convo. NRA people That's the internal debate that NRA is having.
 - Gun safety - don't have to lock up your guns but you are responsible if your child shoots someone.
 - Another Senate bill holding gun manu responsible
 - Semi automatic handgun= ten mag clip and Semi Automatic Rifle
 - HB 72 - probably won't pass. You can put a semi automatic into a fully auto within second. You can add a drum. These are starting to show ups in ABQ made on a 3 d printer. Little pieces of plastic. Bump stock goes on a semi automatic.
 - Ranchers use some of these weapons to take care of coyotes.

- More gun legislation this year than past. There was no one talking about gun violence until NM Against Gun Violence
- When Sandy Hook happened, there was a big rush to buy guns. NM was one of the highest gun purchasing during covid.
- Mass shootings are not killing people - it's more the one on ones.
- HB 9 - 6 dems came out against not Glad that some of the rural seats who flipped to dems. But they are not voting against guns.
- Buy back:
 - Guns to gardens has become national
 - 14 Presbyterian Churches were on board.
 - Turn them into gardening tools.
 - Have taken in over 1700 firearms
 - Walmart stopped selling guns in NM
 - With youth - student pledge against gun violence.
 - From 2015 to right before Covid - there was a % less .
 - Have done 16 throughout the state - murals against gun violence
 - Students tell her how much they appreciated.
 - IN ABQ - an ongoing program to schools Don't go to parties - chances of being shot at parties are big.
 - Site Santa Fe - dismantled gun to instruments. Pedro Reyes - Direct Action
