Today's Speaker was Adam Fulton Johnson newly elected to district 4 SF county council, (unopposed for the general election, taking the seat of Anna Hansen who was term limited) General discussion of his interests and background

- Five pillars of his campaign fire, water, earth, energy, and spirit
 - o Fire the importance of prevention throughout the county
