When this happened in the late 1940 it took until the Kennedys. Her family were in jail because of the civil rights issues. We can explore this together. Little things like not giving information to the Nazis. And a lot of people survived as a result. We are in a space where a lot of people can contribute. The intelligentsia and smart people can contribute. She's been talking to people to keep them safe. Look at how to resist.
